

## Who are we?

The Anglican Missions Board enables the <u>Anglican Church in Aotearoa</u>, New <u>Zealand and Polynesia</u>, in a spirit of partnership, to share in the global dimension to Christ's mission of proclaiming the Gospel, nurturing believers, responding to human need, transforming society, and caring for creation. It achieves this by:

- Challenging Christians constantly to enlarge their sense of mission.
- Raising funds for global missions.
- Resourcing associated Anglican mission agencies, Tikanga mission enterprises and partner Churches.

## Who do we work with?

Anglican Missions works in partnership with churches in Fiji, Tonga, Samoa, Papua New Guinea and the Solomon Islands, Cambodia, Pakistan, Tanzania, Jerusalem and the Middle East. We also make major contributions to the New Zealand Church Missionary Society (NZCMS).

Nativity Church parishioners support Anglican Missions Board and sponsored families who have gone out from Nelson Diocese as missionaries. You can help by praying. Contributing to mission support either through automatic payment, mission envelopes which are available from Nativity Office or by collecting a mission box from the church foyer.

## You can help by:

- Adopting specific missionaries and keeping in contact with them, their work and needs, and supporting them with prayer.
- Making a contribution/donation to 'mission support' by automatic payment into the Nativity account (separate from your regular tithing) or through the mission boxes or mission envelopes (envelopes are available from the office - these donations are deductible)
- Donations to individuals and some overseas charities (these donations are not deductible)
