and deliver us from evil.

and the glory are yours
now and for ever.
Amen.

GIVING OF COMMUNION

The leader moves to the Table and says

The Church of God, of which we are members, has taken bread and wine and given thanks over them according to our Lord's command.

These holy gifts have been kept for us that we too may share in the communion of the body and blood of Christ.

Silence is kept and the leader says

God's holy gifts for God's holy people.

Jesus Christ is holy, Jesus Christ is Lord,
to the glory of God the Father.

The leader and people receive communion.

Prayer after Communion

Silence is kept, and the leader may say a post communion prayer.

All may say
Almighty God,
we thank you for feeding us
with the body and blood of your Son Jesus
Christ.

Through him we offer you our souls and bodies to be a living sacrifice.

Send us out in the power of your Spirit to live and work to your praise and glory.

Amen.

This or some other ending may be used.

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all evermore. Amen.

The leader says

Go now to love and serve the Lord. Go in peace. Amen. We go in the name of Christ.

The Preparation and Readings

The leader may say

Grace and peace to you from God.

God fill you with truth and joy.

The following may be said.

Almighty God,
to whom all hearts are open,
all desires known,
and from whom no secrets are hidden;

by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit,
so that we may truly love you
and worthily praise your holy name:
through our Saviour Jesus Christ.

Amen.

The leader says

Happy are those whose sins are forgiven, whose wrongs are pardoned. I will confess my sins to the Lord, I will not conceal my wrongdoings.

Silence

God forgives and heals us.

We need your healing, merciful God: give us true repentance.

Some sins are plain to us; some escape us, some we cannot face.

Forgive us; set us free to hear your word to us; set us free to serve you. Amen

The leader says

God forgives us. Forgive others; forgive yourself.

Silence

Through Christ, God has put away our sin: approach our God in peace.

Amen.

The bread and wine for communion are prepared.

The Liturgy of Holy Communion THE PEACE

The leader says

In fellowship with the whole Church of God, with all who have been brought together by the Holy Spirit to worship on this day, and who have celebrated the Eucharist, let us rejoice that we are called to be part of the body of Christ.

Though we are many,
we are one body,
because we all share in one bread.

The leader then says

Blessed are the peacemakers: they shall be called children of God. We meet in the name of Christ and share his peace.

The peace of the Lord be always with you.

And also with you.

The leader reads from St Luke's Gospel.

"They recognized him in the breaking of bread"

When he was at the table with them, he took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him; and he vanished from their sight. They said to each other, 'Were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking to us on the road, while he was opening the scriptures to us?' That same hour they got up and returned to Jerusalem; and they found the eleven and their companions gathered together. They were saying, 'The Lord has risen indeed, and he has appeared to Simon! Luke 24.30–34

Blessed are you, God of those who hunger and thirst, for you give us our food in due season.

You nourish us with your word, which is the bread of life.
You strengthen us with your Spirit, the new wine of your Kingdom.
In Christ you are food for the hungry, refreshment for the weary.
Blessed are you, our Creator and Redeemer.
