Dear Nativity family and friends,

Early in the movie Bruce Almighty, there's a well known and very funny scene. The main character (Bruce) is angry, driving his car and asking God for a sign. He gets even angrier as a variety of signals interrupt him. Each of them is exactly what he's asking God for. They culminate in a road works truck laden with signs saying exactly what he needs to do, pulling out in front of him.

"This Advent God is calling us all to waken out of sleep, to look carefully and honestly at our lives, and to watch for the signs. What signs do you see? For the time is fulfilled, the Kingdom of God is upon us."

God has put signs of hope all around us. They're all through history (= "His-Story"). The greatest sign of all was his coming among us in Jesus. Even today he's given us prophets who speak or demonstrate that hope.

We often think of prophets as being negative nay-sayers. In fact they are the bringers of Advent hope, the hope that comes from and points to the coming of God and life in all its fullness, among us. Sometimes they have to say it in ways and words we may find less than peaceful.

Advent – it's an advent-ure. We're on one. There are new tracks to be discovered, old ways to leave behind, experiences from the past to inform us of the future. It's the prophets who bring us close to Jesus as we advent-ure closer to him. Jesus is the supreme prophet – and more than a prophet. Much more. There is much more. That's our hope wherein lies peace.
