
Dear Nativity family and friends,

How good it is to have the freedom to gather with other believers. So whether you're a believer from another church, just looking, or one of the Nativity family, welcome!

In the last few weeks we have started a series of sermons and discussions around what we believe, and what – or who - we really worship. For what we believe, shows up in our behaviour. What we do, shows what we really believe - whatever else we might say. It all comes together to say who we are.

The series started with who we are as individuals before God – we are made in God's image, loved beyond measure. We have **seen** that the God we worship is the greatest example of love personified, and we describe that as the Trinity – one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

This week we see who we are collectively – the church, the gathered community being made in God's image. Church is who we are, not where we go.
