Dear Nativity family and friends,

The last few days have seen the Anglican Parishes of the Nelson Diocese (Top o' the South) having its annual meeting. We call it a "Synod". Parish clergy (Jonathan and Bob) and Synod Reps (Jocelyn Wilkes, Keith Buck and Hamish Harper) all attended. Heather Wadsworth as a Rep for AAW (Association of Anglican Women) was also with us.

Meetings can come across as boring and worse, but there is an importance that means they're needed. God knew he needed to meet his fallen humanity. So he became one of us, to meet us in the person of Jesus. We carry the name of that meeting – "Nativity".

Even the name "Synod" carries some importance we can learn from. It's based on an ancient Latin word, for a church meeting, but which included a sense of conjunction, lining things up. At our meeting of Synod we meet, joining together, trying to line things up. How well we did is another question. But in Jesus, God did exactly that with us. He met us on our ground. It's for us to recognise that, then line up our lives to follow him. So too as a parish we're called to line ourselves up with God's ways.

On our life journey we're all to line ourselves up with God's standards, to go through the narrow gate of God's full life. We show what sort of stuff we're made of by what grows in our life - like fruit on trees. As we join with the love of God we find strength and peace even in the storms of life. There we find healing. There we find wholeness.

It's an adventure. At times it's easy. At other times it's a scramble! But it's good - and the outcome is superb!

We can never remain the same. It's a fact of life that we have to keep adjusting our life course to line up with where God's Holy Spirit is leading. That's true for us as individuals and as a Parish. (Have you heard or seen the plan for the future of Nativity? Check out Bob's sermons from the last 4 weeks on our website – and feel free to chat it over with him.)

- **Wed. Jesus is our Hope.** "May the God of Hope, fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." Romans 15:13
- **Thurs.** *The outcome of hope.* "Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer." Romans 12:12
- **Fri.** We have to testify about our hope. "Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give a reason for the hope you have. But do it with gentleness and respect." I Peter 3:15
- **Sat.** The advantages of hope. "Why are you downcast O my soul? Why so disturbed? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise Him, my Saviour and my God." Psalm 42:11
