The Resurrection of Christ

"Now I should remind you, brothers and sisters, of the good news through which also you are being saved...: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures, and that he was buried, and that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the scriptures...

if Christ has not been raised, then our proclamation has been in vain and your faith has been in vain. We are even found to be misrepresenting God, because we testified of God that he raised Christ....

If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. Then those also who have died in Christ have perished. If for this life only we have hoped in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied.

But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have died."

Readings 8am: Psalm 22 & 1 Corinthians 15:12-28

Sentence: Alleluia! The Lord is risen indeed. To him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Alleluia! *Luke 24:34: Revelation 1:6*

Collects: Jesus Christ our Saviour, you have delivered us from death and sin. You have brought with the dawn a new beginning and an empty tomb; grant us strength and humility to enter into life. **Amen.**



WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS:

Resurrection – a new way of seeing life. Because of the empty tomb our lives have new meaning.

- **Mon.** We thank You for the two disciples on the Emmaus Rd., and how Jesus shared their disappointment and sorrow and helped them find hope and a new beginning.
- **Tues.** Think of someone whose journey through life is filled with pain someone who is ill and whose illness dominated the whole if their life.
- **Wed.** Think of someone whose journey is filled with joy someone whose life has been changed by the love and power of God.
- **Thurs.** Think of someone who has lost their way and whose journey is confused. Someone who has lost sight of the presence of God.
- **Fri.** Think of someone who is facing a time of great pressure and conflict, someone whose life is filled with arguments, misunderstandings and division.
- **Sat.** Think of yourself and of where you are on the journey of life and of the part Jesus plays in the direction it is taking. Ask for a fresh Emmaus experience in your life.
