Dear Nativity family and friends,

At the end of Maori language week, Tena koutou, tena koutou, tena koutou katoa. Welcome to our visitors today. It's good to be together. We were made to be in community. As the Lord God commented at creation

'It is not good that the man should be alone" (Genesis 2 v18)

For that reason we come together week by week – and during the week in our carecells and other small groups – to grow in community, as a community of faith. We do that in all sorts of different ways because we learn and worship in different ways. That's why we have different services.

We also recognise we have a call to make a difference in the wider community – our community connections. In recent weeks we've been considering that call in our services. We looked at what excites us in our lives to share God's love with others. On Fathers Day we faced how we make a difference with those we rub shoulders with. Last Sunday was about our community connections with those who can no longer make it to worship. It also had a subtle suggestion about care in the event of a disaster. Do you know your neighbours?

For many years our Friday morning Tunes For Tots has been blessing families with pre-school age children. On Friday afternoons Link provides company with some fun and games for those at the other end of life. Two years ago we took up the opportunity to reach out to Marlborough youth via our Girls College. We employed Rose as a 24-7 youth worker and as our Parish Youth Coordinator. Now she is connecting with young people bringing them more fully into community as they and we were created for.

Yes, we were all made to be in community. Are you in a carecell? As a community of faith we are helping to make community connections.
