


New Year's Eve. It would be great if people could bring a small plate for supper. Further details contact 5792263.

As Christmas comes round year by year, we are tempted to say "We have heard all this so many times, before.... forgive us Lord, and remind us of the difference between knowing about it, knowing it, and letting it speak to us again and again.

- **Mon.** Help us Lord, to see ourselves and our own attitudes lived out by people in the Christmas story.
- **Tues.** We think about the inn-keeper, who couldn't find room for you in the inn.
- **Wed.** We remember Herod: hostile, jealous, and hating, because he was afraid of what your coming might do to him.
- **Thurs.** The shepherds: who were scorned by others as unskilled labourers, but the heard the music of your coming even while they worked.
- **Fri.** The wise men from the east, who journeyed far to find you.
- **Sat.** Teach us again, Eternal God, that those who really seek will find, and may we never rest content until we have been found by you.
