


The Church of the Nativity

Prayer Focus

This is our last week using the alphabet as our prayer focus.

- Mon. S Spiritual Warfare. This subject is so big where do we start! Ephesian 6 focuses on the weapons for spiritual warfare. The Belt of Truth. The Breastplate of righteousness. The Boots of the Gospel of Peace. The Shield of Faith. The Helmet of Salvation, The Sword of the Spirit. Thank God for the armour he gives us for the battle..
- **Tues.** *T Thanksgiving.* Count your blessings. Communicate verbally to God your gratitude. When the 10 lepers were healed, only one went back to Jesus to say thanks. T- Today read 1Thessalonians 5:18 ... give thanks.
- Wed. U Using time twice over. Here's a challenge for today! How many times during the day can you pray while you are doing something else? (having a shower, preparing food, driving a car, walking, gardening, standing in a queue....) Try it you will be blessed.
- **Thurs.** *V Be Thou my VISION.* Vision the faculty of seeing. Sight. Pray that God will open our eyes so we can see people, situations and needs with the eyes of Jesus. Pray for the gift of his Spirit.
- **Fri. W Worship.** Worship is something that happens spontaneously in our spirit. We can't define it but we can experience it? It is our innermost being responding to God. Sing a worship song today.
- **Sat.** X Xtras. Thank the Lord for the extras in your life....
