Theme 8am & 10am: How we treat each other

Readings: 8am & 10am: Song of Songs 8:10-14 & Matthew 27:50-54

**Sentence:** Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will uphold you with my saving right hand.

**Collect:** Creator God, you have made us not in one mould, but in many: so deepen our unity in Jesus that we may rejoice in our diversity. **Amen** 

**WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS:** From the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead, we can learn certain lessons.

- **Mon.** The first lesson is about REASON. Mary and Martha didn't send for Jesus until they had exhausted all they could do for Lazarus.
- **Tues.** The second lesson is about RELATIONSHIP. It is hard to go to someone when you are in trouble if you have spent no time building a relationship with them. Jesus often spent time at the home of Mary and Martha.
- **Wed,** The third lesson is RELINQUISHMENT. Mary and Martha could not fix the problem of Lazarus' ill health and death. They handed it over to Jesus.
- **Thurs.** Fourth lesson RADICAL FAITH which says "Lord, I believe you can turn this situation around."
- **Fri.** Fifth lesson is about RESTORATION. The sisters sent for Jesus. You never know what the Lord can do until you invite him into your situation. He can restore what life has taken from you and more.
- Sat. "Now a certain man was sick, Lazarus of Bethany." John 11:1. Lazarus was given a reprieve from death. Jesus conquered death. Hallelujah! What a Saviour.
