The new Nativity Prayer Directory is at the back of the church. Please collect your copy as you leave today. On 05 July Miriam will undertake her




ninth mission trip to Aworor Village, on Gaua Island in northern Vanuatu. Donations towards the purchase of stationery, and building renovations at school and church would
