Dear Nativity family and friends

Since our announcement two weeks ago, we have been overwhelmed, blessed, encouraged and touched with words of kindness, words of love, words of encouragement and yes words of sorrow. Thank you from the depths of our hearts. Your acts of kindness and love have certainly helped us in what has been a challenging time for us.

We are reminded in Galatians 6:10 "Therefore, as we have the opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers" – we certainly have been the recipients of that, not just in the last two weeks but in the almost 7 years we have been here.

Acts of kindness can be performed in so many ways and Nativity family, you are so good at this. When we have the opportunity to review a place we have stayed at or eaten at, we rarely give the place 5 stars - although there has been the odd exception – because we believe there can always be room for improvement. Likewise, in being a Christian, our aim should be to increasingly be more like Jesus in character and actions. Last week in the 10am service, Jonathan had us tying different coloured pieces of wool together then we had to weave the wool between our fingers – demonstrating how God weaves us together. We

are all different but together, demonstrating **God's mercy, love and kindness** – we find strength, purpose and vision.

In Galatians 6:9 it says — "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time, we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."

So, keep doing what you are doing – and more!

Weekly Prayer Focus

2 Kings 4:8 – Elisha went to Shunem where there was a notable woman who in turn gave him food, shelter and built a small room where he could rest.

- **Mon.** That room had a **bed.** We all need times when we can rest. If we don't slow down we will break down.
- **Tues.** A **table** was in that room. We must have time for spiritual food, reading God's word. We can't give out to others. without taking in fresh food and insight.
- **Wed.** A **chair.** This speaks of study. Study to present yourself to God... A work environment...who has no cause to be ashamed.
- **Thurs.** A **lamp**. Even after studying long and hard, we need the Holy Spirit to reveal truths to our heart and mind.
- **Fri.** Because of the woman's generosity to Elisha, she experienced miracles, she had a child when she wasn't expected to.
- **Sat.** Later Elisha raised that child from death when sickness claimed him. When you make room for God in your life, you make room for unexpected blessings. Thank God for the blessings in your life.
