material provided - bring a vase to arrange in. Come and have some fun. \$2 per person, All welcome – bring a friend. RSVP Viv Peters, 578 7685.


**She Shops** June 15th to Elim Centre 26 Burleigh Road. Clothes drop off Mon

Soup will be served approx.11.30am onwards. Vegetarian/vegan/gluten/dairy free will be available.


April's soup lunch was a great success, with everyone enjoying fellowship and socialising.

This week we will use some verses from Scripture as prompts for prayer.

- Mon. May the God of Hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. Romans 15:13
- Tues. Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive and your joy will be complete. John 16:24
- Wed. Why are you downcast, O my soul? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise Him, my Saviour and my God. Psalm 43:5
- **Thurs.** I have told you this so that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be complete. John 15:11
- Fri. A faith and knowledge resting on the hope of eternal life, which God, who does not lie, promised before the beginning of time.
- Sat. For I know the plans I have for you; declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." Jeremiah 19:11
- Sun. I thank my God every time I remember you. *Philippians 1:3*
