Dear Nativity family and friends,

Welcome, to Shavot, better known in the Western part of the global church as Pentecost. It's the birthday of the church, but much more than that too.

It's an ancient Jewish festival known to them as "Shavot". As such it's always been about life, the giver of it and how we recognise and access it. Originally a harvest thanksgiving, it became one of the major Jewish festivals. Nearly 2000 years ago it became a major Christian one, connected with Easter and Ascension. It's the day when God made his Holy Spirit, the giver of life, available to all who will accept the rule of Jesus in their lives.

Life doesn't become easier for those who receive the Holy Spirit. New things happen. Life gets turned upside down as we live faith at a new level. Yet there is amazing peace at the core of it!

One of the ways we are seeing that is in the development and strengthening of our children's and youth ministry. This year God has led us into new uncharted paths. We'd had that prophetic message for the previous 18 months. At this stage they're only small changes, yet they've been lifegiving.

Canvas, our evening service has been a real breath of life for quite a few of our families, as old patterns gave way to new hope for them. For the rest of this school term our primary age children will be in Barnies, and our teens will be in the rooms off the hall.

So, this week we explore what the Church teaches about the Holy Spirit, how the Holy Spirit reveals truth, is active in the life of people and the Church today, and what fruit - or evidence - we should and can see of the Holy Spirit. This is exciting territory. Come on the journey!

Theme 8am & 10am: A Catechism - God the Spirit

Readings 8am & 10am: Acts 2:1-4 & 2 Corinthians 3:13-18

**Sentence:** The love of God has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us. *Romans 5:5* 

**Collect:** Father, you have filled your people with the Spirit who rested first on your Son and united us in your Church: open the channels for your Spirit that we may freely work together, and your kingdom and your rule increase. **Amen** 

## **Weekly Prayer Focus:**

Francois Fenelon, a 17th Century Frenchman, gives a prayer Formula that has been used over the centuries as a guide and help for prayer.

- **Mon.** Tell God all that is in your heart, as one unloads its pleasures and its pain to a close friend.
- **Tues.** Tell him your troubles that he may comfort you. Tell him your longings that he may purify them.
- **Wed.** Tell him your dislikes that he may help you to conquer them. Tell him your temptations that he may shield you from them.
- **Thurs.** Tell him about your physical pain, and the wounds of your soul. Ask for healing. Lay before God your instability and indifference.
- **Fri.** Tell him how self-love makes you critical of others. Tell him how pride and insincerity hides you from yourself and others.
- **Sat.** When you pray, ask in faith, confident that you will be heard. Blessed are those who attain such familiar open communication with God.

## Winter half day retreats:


9am to midday
