

# The Church of the Nativity

Our Mission is ...

To draw people to faith in Christ
To grow people in their commitment to Christ
To reach out beyond ourselves with the love of Christ

God's intention is to re-create us into the likeness of his Son Jesus. And he has given us four resources to help: the cross, the Spirit, the word and prayer.

**The cross.** The cross deals with three areas of broken relationships. It makes forgiveness possible and healing available for past hurts and our self-centred, sinful nature has been dealt with.

The second is his **Spirit**. It is the Spirit who brings vitality, refreshment, comfort, support and new life. It is the Spirit who reveals sin in our lives, not to condemn but to heal. It is the Spirit who will produce the fruit of humility. It is the Spirit who re-sensitises our conscience. Without the Spirit there is no Christian life.

The third is his **word**, the Bible. It is the foundation on which we build our lives. As we read it, meditate on it and pray it in, it challenges and changes the way we think and live. It sets a standard. It probes our motives. It feeds us. It brings comfort and hope.

The fourth resource is **prayer**. It is said: If God's Word is food to the Christian then prayer must be the Christian's breath.

Prayer and fellowship with the Father was central in the life of Jesus. What strength he must have gained from his hours in prayer. Of all the resources that we have been given, prayer is the most neglected. There is nothing that causes us to love people so much as praying for them.


