Being "Number One" is the theme of today's sermon and we will be looking at what lays at the core of relationship break down. We will note that there are four big 'C's' that affect us — "competition", which leads to comparison which leads to either "conceit" or "covetousness".

The Christian community is to be a safe place – safe from competition, safe from comparisons where each person is able to be just who they are. It is to be a place of mutual support and encouragement so we can grow in our gifts, abilities and Christ likeness.

This is what Paul tells us in Ephesians 4:12-16. Gifts are given to the Church – 'to prepare God's people for works of service... so that the body of Christ may be built up...(to) reach unity ...become mature... attaining fullness of Christ...as it... builds itself up in love, as each part does its work'. Clearly each part is important. There is absolutely no place for competition, comparison, covetousness or conceit. This is God's idea of a 'win-win' situation. Go well and blessings, Richard
