Prayer Focus

Prayer is a subject much bigger than a whole library of books. Over the next few weeks we will use the alphabet to help us grow in our prayer life.

Mon. A... Some Advice.

Talking about prayer is not enough. To grow spiritually, we must actually pray. To pray is to let Jesus come into your life. To pray is to let Jesus come into your needs. To pray is to glorify his name in your life.

Tues. The Prayer of Blessing Numbers 6: 22-27

Bless people when they come to your mind today. "Father Bless Keep them in the light of your face and under the banner of your love."

Wed. C... Confession.

Write down a list of sins, shortcoming and failures as the Holy Spirit reveals them to you. Now take God as his Word "If we confess our sins. He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins..." God has said it... believe it.

Thurs. Doubts... Difficulties...Distractions...

There is no easy answer. Everyone has to battle through doubts, difficulties, and distractions. Are there situations in your life that seem without hope? Instead of feeling discouraged offer God a sacrifice of praise.

Fri. Expecting God to Answer. When we study the life of Jesus, it is clear that at the heart of his life was prayer and as a result he was able to meet every need, every challenge, every emergency with power and calmness. Jesus says to us "do likewise."

Sat. Prayer and Fasting. Jesus did not say "If you fast" he said, "When you fast.' In a small way give a fast to the Lord today – perhaps go without a meal, or a coffee, or an hours sleep.... Make that a prayer time.
