We worship One often called "*The God of the 2*<sup>nd</sup> chances". How many times do we need a 2<sup>nd</sup> chance? How many times DON'T we?

It's no new human condition. Ever since people started messing up we have needed a 2<sup>nd</sup> shot, a new start. People refuse it to each



other out of fear of being hurt (again) and for all sorts of reasons. We refuse to accept it when offered, maybe in case it's a hoax. Only God is really serious and constantly reliable about it. He's been offering it for a very long time. From the very first, when humanity first rebelled, God made a promise of a way back when he said:

#### **WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS:**

How Great Is Our God .....?
