Dear Nativity family and friends,

Welcome to "Stir-up Sunday"

That's an old nickname for the Sunday before the pre-Christmas season of Advent. Today is that Sunday before Advent. The nickname comes partly from an old prayer that was always used at this time of year. It reads (in modern English)

> "Stir up, O Lord, the wills of your faithful people that, richly bearing the fruit of good works, they may by you be richly rewarded; through Jesus Christ our Lord"

We all need a bit of a stir-up from time to time, or like a Christmas cake being put together, the mixture won't have the necessary taste or stickability. And if anyone is going to dish-out the stirring up, much better it be God than anyone else! At least we can trust God to be fair. Many in society treat this season as a warm up to Christmas. It might as well be Krismiss for what inclusion of the Christ Child or his mass (=mission) is acknowledged.

These weeks of Advent, remind us Jesus will return again. So, let's seek God for how he wants us to make his hope and purposes for his world known. Then as the Christ's mass approaches his hope and purposes can be truly celebrated and represented, through us, to his lost world.

"Therefore prepare your minds for action; discipline yourselves; set all your hope on the grace that Jesus Christ will bring you when he is revealed (1 Peter 1:13)

Theme 8am & 10am: Signs of His Coming

Readings 8am & 10am: Isaiah 25:1-9 & 1 Peter 1:3-12

Collect: Keep us hopeful, Holy Spirit, knowing that Christ will come again. Keep your church alert, ready to hear when you are calling, and when you challenge us. **Amen.**

WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS:

Hebrews 6:1 says "Therefore let us...go on to maturity." Bob Gass suggests we read carefully and prayerfully the following words about maturity.

- **Mon.** Maturity is the ability to control your anger and settle your differences without violence or resentment.
- **Tues.** Maturity is patience. It's the willingness to pass up immediate pleasure for long term gain. It's the capacity to face unpleasantness and frustration without complaining or collapsing.
- **Wed.** Maturity is humility. It's being big enough to say, "I was wrong." and when you're right, never needing to say, "I told you so."
- **Thurs.** Maturity is the ability to make a decision and follow through on it, instead of exploring endless possibilities and doing nothing about any of them.
- **Fri.** Maturity means dependability, keeping your word and coming through in a crisis.
- **Sat.** Maturity is the art of being at peace with what you can't change, having the courage to change what you can, and having the wisdom to know the difference.

Pray today that we will all "go on to maturity."
