Dear Nativity family and friends,

Abraham is known as the father of those who believe, yet he was an ordinary man just like any of us. He was not special in and of himself, yet God chose Abraham from among all the people of the earth and made a covenant with him. God promised Abraham a blessing for him and his descendants. Abraham did nothing to earn the blessing that God bestowed upon him, all he did was he believed God and was obedient to his call.

Today God is calling each and every one of us to faith in Jesus Christ. God has promised a blessing, salvation and an inheritance in the kingdom of heaven to those who believe and accept this call. This is not something that we have earned, or indeed can earn. It is a free gift that God bestows upon all who repent and believe and are obedient to his calling.

Paul urged the Christians of Galatia to believe God and to accept the gift of salvation in Christ as freely given grace, just as Abraham did. He warned his followers that they could not earn this salvation by human effort through the works of the law.

What will you choose to do this day? Will you live by faith and believing God and embracing the call that he has for you, or will you struggle along trying to please God with human effort?

Weekly Prayer Focus

Whatever problems you are facing in your life at the moment.... whatever problems you are facing at work, at church. God has given us seven life-changing truths that we need to learn and put into practice. We read about these in Luke 5:4-11

- **Mon.** Jesus will come to you and help you.... wherever those problems are: at work, at home, in our church.
- **Tues.** When what you are doing is not working, Jesus will show you a better way.
- **Wed.** Even though it may not make sense at the moment, do what He tells you to do.
- **Thurs.** The success He has in mind for you is greater than anything you can envision for yourself.
- **Fri.** Your existing systems may not be able to handle what He has in mind for you, so be willing to change how you do things.
- **Sat.** When you experience His goodness, take time to thank Him and acknowledge Him as Lord.
- **Sun.** When you realise what He has in mind for you, be thankful and courageous, and leave everything and follow Him.
