Weekly Prayer Focus

Psalm 119 we find many rules for clean living in a dirty world.

- **Mon.** Seek the Lord on a regular basis. "I seek you with all my heart, do not let me stray from your commands." v.10. Include God in all your decisions, plans, struggles and your fun times.
- **Tues.** Hide His precepts in your heart. "I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you. v.11.
- **Wed.** Talk to others about God. "I recount all the laws that come from your mouth. v.13. Something wonderful happens when you begin to talk about the things of God.
- **Thurs.** Rejoice in Him. "I rejoice in following your statutes." v.14 Smile others are watching. Let your delight show!
- **Fri.** Meditate on His Word throughout the day. "I meditate on Your precepts and consider Your ways." v. 15
- **Sat.** Weave into your driving time, your workouts, your quiet time, your meal time, a verse from scripture to remind you of God's presence.
