Shot in the Foot. No one likes the idea of doing damage to one's self but all too often we shoot our leadership, our activities or ourselves in the foot and cripple our potential. Why do we permit prejudice to disrupt our relationships, create unbelief and restrict the operation of the gifts of God's Spirit? It's not


Missional needs: Please pray for the following.

Prayer Focus

Edgar G Watts of California aged 84, read the Bible from cover to cover 161 times – and he only had the use of one eye! Now there's a challenge for us all.



- **Mon.** Why does the Bible remain the world's most widely read book? One simple reason you read every other book the Bible reads you.
- **Tues.** Your soul cannot thrive without God's Word- just as your body cannot thrive without a daily intake of food. Pray that truth into the lives of your family and friends.
- **Wed.** Developing a love for scripture requires three things. First *DECISION.* Unless we establish Bible reading as a daily priority, it will never happen.
- **Thurs.** Next *DUTY*. You may not feel like (e.g.) going to work, but you know it's your duty, so you do it. Pray today that you will stay strong over your Bible reading.
- **Fri.** When you reach the stage of *DELIGHT* over reading the Bible the battle is won!
- Sat. One of the dangers of the IPhone is that you live on small "hits" of information. God cannot be reduced to a brief word count.
