**Theme 8am & 10am:** A Catechism—Who are we?

**Readings 8am & 10am:** Romans 8:14-17 & John 14:1-7



**Sentence:** Jesus said, If you dwell within the revelation I have brought, you are indeed my disciples; you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. John 8:31,32

**Collect:** Loving God, in Jesus you gather us into your family; confidently we call you Father; may your Spirit bring us to share the glorious liberty of your children. **Amen** 

### **Weekly Prayer Focus:**

James 1:19 - 25 gives us six practical commands. "Do not merely listen to the Word... do what it says....

- **Mon**. "Be quick to listen." Pray that as a Church and as individuals we will listen to what God says to us in his Word.
- **Tues**. *"Be slow to speak."* Thank God for the gift of speech- pray that we will use the gift wisely. Pray for those who cannot speak.
- **Wed**. "Be slow to become angry." Anger is a choice you can choose to be angry you can choose not to be angry. Pray for families living with anger.
- **Thurs**. "Get rid of all moral filth." Be sensitive to the evil that bombards us through the media. Pray for discernment for our young folk and families.
- **Fri**. "Accept the Word." This means opening yourself to the Word reading it, studying it, and above all believing it.
- **Sat**. "Do what the Word says." If you hear the truth. Lord, I get the point. If I don't put things right as soon as You point them out to me, then my time spent reading your Word is of no profit. Help me to develop a deep sense of immediacy in my daily walk with you. In Jesus Name. Amen


