Weekly Prayer Focus:

Here is a Bible First Aid Kit – use it – it works!

- **Mon.** If you find yourself in sudden trouble or sorrow, apply instantly Hebrews 12:5 11 and saturate your heart in Psalm 23.
- **Tues.** If you have slipped down and hurt yourself, Psalm 91 will be a great help to you.
- Wed. When you are feeling very lonely, Matthew 11:28 30 will be a great help to you.
- **Thurs.** Should you be suffering from loss of memory and cannot recall all your blessings, try a good dose of Psalm 103.
- **Fri.** If you are feeling unwell, and lacking strength or energy, try two or three applications of 1 John 5:13 15
- **Sat.** Whenever you find that bitter taste in your mouth and cannot speak lovingly of others, take a good dose of 1 Corinthians 13 and Psalm 34: 12,13.
- **Sun.** Some days when your faith is weak try the tonic found in Hebrews 11.
