Dear Nativity family and friends,

We are welcomed by our God and his angels into Heaven. As we arrive at worship each week it's a foretaste of Heaven. So welcome here today!

The celebrations in Heaven are very much about our being rescued from being in a lifestyle that ends in loneliness and death – separation from God, separation from all that represents love. Our reason for celebrating here is that same thing – though sometimes we lose sight of that, and are just glad that others are part of our church.

Today we are asking 2 questions:

- 1 Have you handed control of your life to Jesus? Are you the cause of celebrations in Heaven and on Earth in Jesus's church? If not, why not, and what about it????
- 2 What are you going to do about it?

Once you have done the 1st, then we really need to make a public stand. A change of life to follow Jesus is no private matter. It's earth changing stuff! Jesus commands us to make a response by being baptised – us and our families, unless they are unwilling. In the New Testament whole households were baptised. Babies, children, adults and their old people.

"For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are far off." (Acts 2:39)

In the early years of the Christian church, after people were baptised – particularly those who'd been baptised as infants – it became obvious they needed to confirm before the church, that they had indeed chosen to follow Jesus. So, they learned what following Jesus entailed. They renewed the vows made at Baptism, for themselves. The church prayed for them and the Bishop laid hands on them, commissioning them as witnesses to Jesus, and to his service in the world.

On September 23 our Bishop, Richard Ellena will be here. If you would like to talk with someone about being Baptised; or in Confirmation to be commissioned (or re commissioned) on that date as an adult disciple of Jesus, please let one of the Parish Clergy, or your care cell leader, know as soon as possible.

"Therefore, brothers and sisters, be all the more eager to **confirm** your call and election, for if you do this, you will never stumble" (2 Peter 1:10)
