

## Welcome to Nativity

Today is an especially welcoming sort of day. It's called Palm Sunday, when we remember that Jesus was welcomed into Jerusalem as a King.

When we are made welcome we hope people will get it right about who we are. Unfortunately for Jesus the crowds who welcomed him that day only got it partly right. That sometimes happens to all of us.



Because he has experienced what we have and more, and then come through, we can trust him. Often on Palm Sunday, flax or palm leaf Crosses are handed out. They've been made by some of the Nativity women. They are to remind us through the coming year that when we are misunderstood or wrongly treated, God in Jesus is there to walk us through it.

So put your cross somewhere you will see it most days. Thank Jesus each day for what it represents. Then next year bring it back on Ash Wednesday (14 February). In the meantime every day welcome Jesus into your day – its business, its fun, its hard times. Let him lead you as the most humble yet most noble King he is, in your behaviours and your relationships, in every part of your life.

## Welcome to our services today! 9th April 2017

Theme 8am & 10am: Palm Sunday: Humility

Readings 8am & 10am: Philippians 2:5-11 & Matthew 20:22-28

**Sentence:** Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest! *Matthew 21:9* 

**Collects:** Jesus, when you rode into Jerusalem the people waved palms with shouts of acclamation. Grant that when the shouting dies we may still walk beside you even to a cross. **Amen** 



#### **WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS:**

As we approach Easter we will think of Jesus seamless robe.

- **Mon.** John 19 tells us "they took his robe" It was seamless. woven in one piece from the top. It was traditional for Jewish mothers to make these garments for their sons. We don't know if it was Mary's garment. Thank God today for Mary.
- **Tues.** When Jesus was crucified he set aside his seamless robe, changed placed with us and put on the robe of sin that had our names on it. Pray today for Easter services.
- **Wed.** Jesus died like a common criminal for sins he didn't commit, so that we could wear the garment of his righteousness. Pray for the outreach of the Easter message through media and Services.
- **Thurs.** In the Bible clothes symbolised behaviour and character. Peter wrote about being clothed with humility, Paul says to put on Christlikeness like new clothes. Pray about your wardrobe.
- **Fri.** Not only did Jesus prepare a place in heaven for us, He made sure we'd be properly dressed for the occasion.
- **Sat.** Pray today that the message of Easter will become a blessed truth and reality to your family and friends.
