Dear Nativity family and friends,


"I woke up. I have a roof over my head.

Hope is the 2nd Advent Candle, following the Love candle we lit last Sunday.

Jesus is the Hope of the world, and it's our privilege to make that Hope known. Care and Justice are 2 of the primary marks of Christian mission recognised by the global Anglican Communion.

He has told you, O mortal, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? (Micah 6 v8)



Jesus' earliest years were spent as a refugee in a foreign land after his family fled persecution. Millions of people around the world today live similarly for years as refugees. Christians are particularly vulnerable because often they're the minority in countries that are hostile to the faith of Jesus people. During this season named for the coming of Jesus we represent him. We can bring hope where there is none.
