#### Dear friends

Welcome to Nativity Church to our visitors, and to our Nativity family, it's good to be together again at each of our services today.

Public worship is a time of the week when we can get sorted and reconciled within ourselves at a level and in a way we can't anywhere else. So here are some questions to mull on as you start to worship.

- \* Why do we need reconciliation with God? \* What must we do to be reconciled with God?
- \* How should our need to be reconciled with God shape our actions?

As you consider these questions, think about what reconciliation is. It's when former enemies make peace with each other. Yes - we have been at war with God.

It's when we finally give in and agree with something we had rejected. Yes – we have often had very different ideas about what's good for us, than what God has.

It's when something becomes compatible. Yes – we have not always lived in ways that were compatible with God's intentions for us.

So look again at those questions. In the sermon today they will be central. In prayer talk it through with God. At the invitation to Communion come and share a common union with God and his people around the world. Then go to the prayer ministers and ask them to pray for full reconciliation for you.

And as you leave, go into the world in peace.

"... if while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of his Son, much more surely, having been reconciled, will we be saved by his life (Romans 5:10)

#### **WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS**

Here are a few ideas that may help with your daily prayer thoughts.

- **Mon.** Give God your **waking** thoughts. Offer God the first few thoughts of the day. Thank God for the night's rest "Today belongs to You."
- **Tues.** Give God your **waiting** thoughts. When you are in the supermarket or traffic queue in fact any time of waiting.
- **Wed.** Give God your **whispering** thoughts. Brief prayers can be whispered anywhere in any circumstance. Let your kitchen become a cathedral.
- **Thurs.** Give God your **working** prayers with a brief prayer for your colleagues and your work situation.
- **Fri.** Give God your **watchful** prayers whenever a family member or friend comes into your mind, offer a brief prayer of thanks and protection.
- **Sat.** Give God your **waning** thoughts at the end of the day, conclude the day as you began it- remember His promise "He who watches over you will neither slumber nor sleep." Psalm 121:4
