#### **ROYAL COMMISSION - ABUSE IN CARE**

Further to the Royal Commission 'Abuse in Care' Inquiry of November 2019, the Nelson Diocese would like to highlight the following notice from the Royal Commission.

While the following notice is primarily addressed to those who made claims of abuse between 1950-1999, the Royal Commission would like to hear from any victim, survivor or other who would like to make a submission related to this inquiry.

If you have been a victim of abuse within the Anglican Church, we encourage you to contact the Royal Commission.

We apologise for the extremely late notice of the deadline for these submissions, as the Royal Commission provided us with this date and request for circulation only this week.

The Royal Commission of Inquiry into historic abuse in faith-based care will be holding its redress hearing from Monday 23 November to Friday 11 December 2020. This hearing will focus on the redress processes of the Catholic Church, Anglican Church and Salvation Army.

We want to hear from survivors and others who have been involved in making claims of abuse while in Faith-based care. This could be complaints directly to a Church or a Faith-based Institution, or by filing civil proceedings in Court or the Human Rights Review Tribunal.

We also want to hear from victims about their experience in seeking and receiving redress or justice. This could be monetary or non-monetary processes. We welcome hearing from other people who might have information to share about a claim of abuse in Faith-based care including family or whānau of the claimant, a legal representative or advocate.

If you have been involved in claims relating to the Catholic Church, Anglican Church or Salvation Army, and would be interested in being considered by the Royal Commission to give evidence at a public hearing into Faith-based redress, we would also like to hear from you by 21 June 2020.
