SENTENCE I am the vine, you are the branches. Those who abide in


me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from

REFLECTIVE PRAYER

Prayer shouldn't be for show.

Matthew 6:6

But you, when you pray, enter into your closet, and when you have shut the door, pray to your Father in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.

Prayer is a private conversation between a child of God and his or her Father. It's not a performance. Prayer is not the end of a spiritual talent show. It's the overflow of a sinner saved by grace, who is intentional about saying thanks. Prayer comes from the heart of a questioner who really wants to know what God thinks. It voices concern by one sinner for another, it's praise, worship and wonder. Prayer is turning to God because you need to talk.

Prayer:

Dear God, May my search for approval end with Your acceptance. Help me use prayer to learn more about Your plans for me, not as a way to feel more significant around people. Remind me that I'll never find a greater listener than You. Amen.
