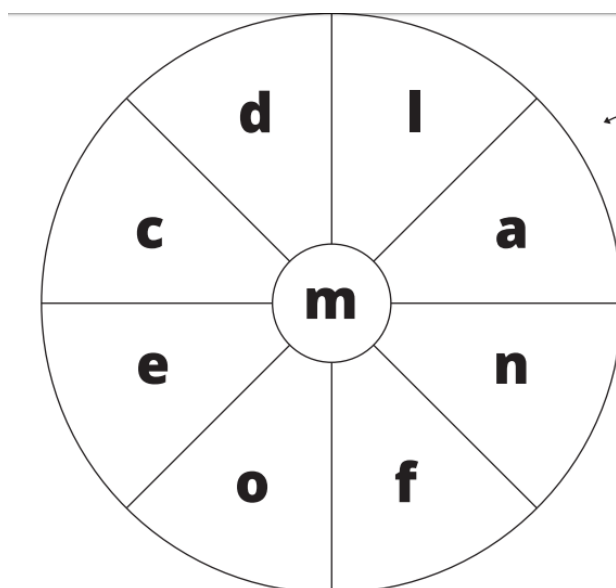

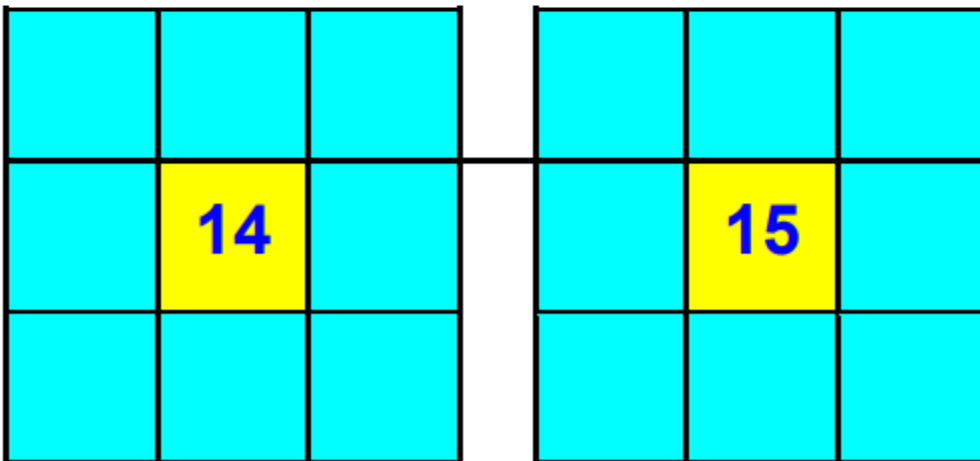
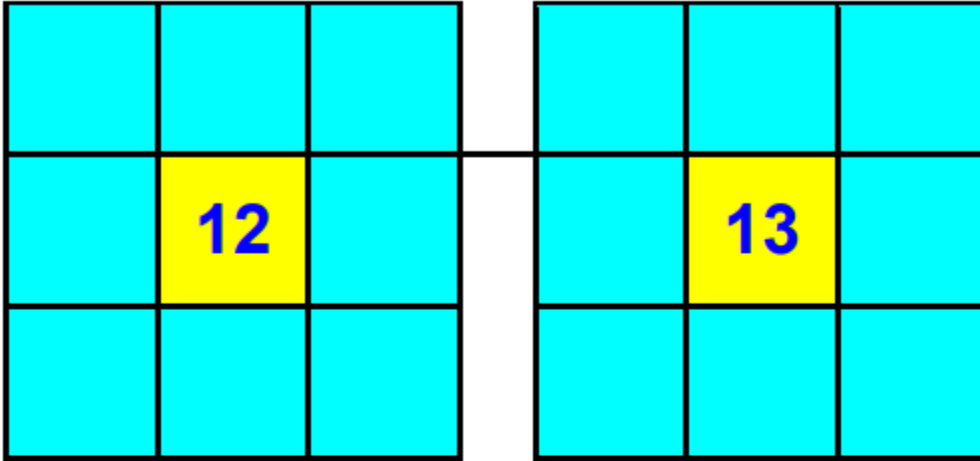
Word Game
