



Notes from Vestry Meeting held 17th October 2018

Rev Robin Kingston has been conducting the Parish Operational Review. He reported progress to Vestry and outlined the timetable to completion. The Wardens have now briefed all congregations regarding the review, timetable, progress, and possible outcomes.

The first trial of an 'intergenerational' service being run parallel to the 10am service was held on Sunday 28th October in Barnies.

Health and Safety:

- Six of Nativity's Administration Policies have been updated to reflect and incorporate new Health and Safety requirements. These have been reviewed and approved as Nativity Policy.
